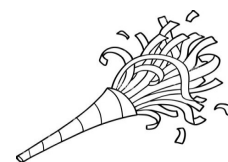


- The first recorded use of artificial flies for fishing was around 200 AD in Rome.

Curriculum Update

SPECIAL EVENT

This 2026 HOLDEN ARBORETUM EVENT will feature guest speaker LANCE STURGILL. Lance is a combat Veteran with a fascinating history. He currently resides in the Cleveland area. Lance will be sharing techniques on how to save money by making your own BRAIDED LEADERS and BRUSHES for fly tying. After that portion of his presentation, additional materials will be provided so you can tie a fly using one of his brushes!

After lunch, Lance will change gears and focus on Skagit casting. Skagit casting is a modern fly-fishing technique used primarily for targeting steelhead and salmon. It is effective because anglers are able to cast efficiently in tight spaces.

So, bring your fly-tying vise-tools and your COFFEE MUG to the Thayer Building at Holden Arboretum on Saturday, January 31st. The address is 9550 Sperry Rd., Kirtland, OH 44094. Arrive by 9:30 AM. It will conclude at 2:00 PM.

As in previous years, POTF will provide a light breakfast and a lunch. Remember to bring your own coffee mug. There will be a prize for **THE MOST AMAZING COFFEE MUG**, so make sure to have fun with that! This contest is open to all Ambassadors, Patriots and Volunteers in attendance. 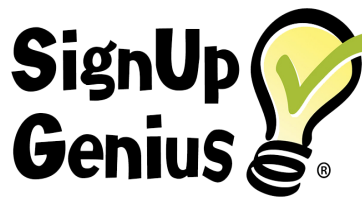
Are you aware that Patriots On The Fly has a YouTube channel?

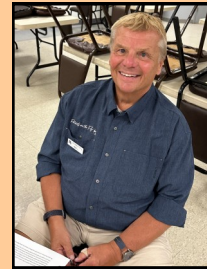
Ambassador News
